<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Shows understanding of rules of perspective● Horizontal lines slant towards vanishing points● Vertical lines are vertical (straight up and down)

<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Relative size of trees, people, etc. show understanding of rules of perspective

<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Careful shading, no sketchiness● Skillful use of watercolor techniques (wet into wet, etc.)

<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Blends colors to create custom colors● Uses warm and cool colors● Shadows are a cool color (not just brown or grey)
